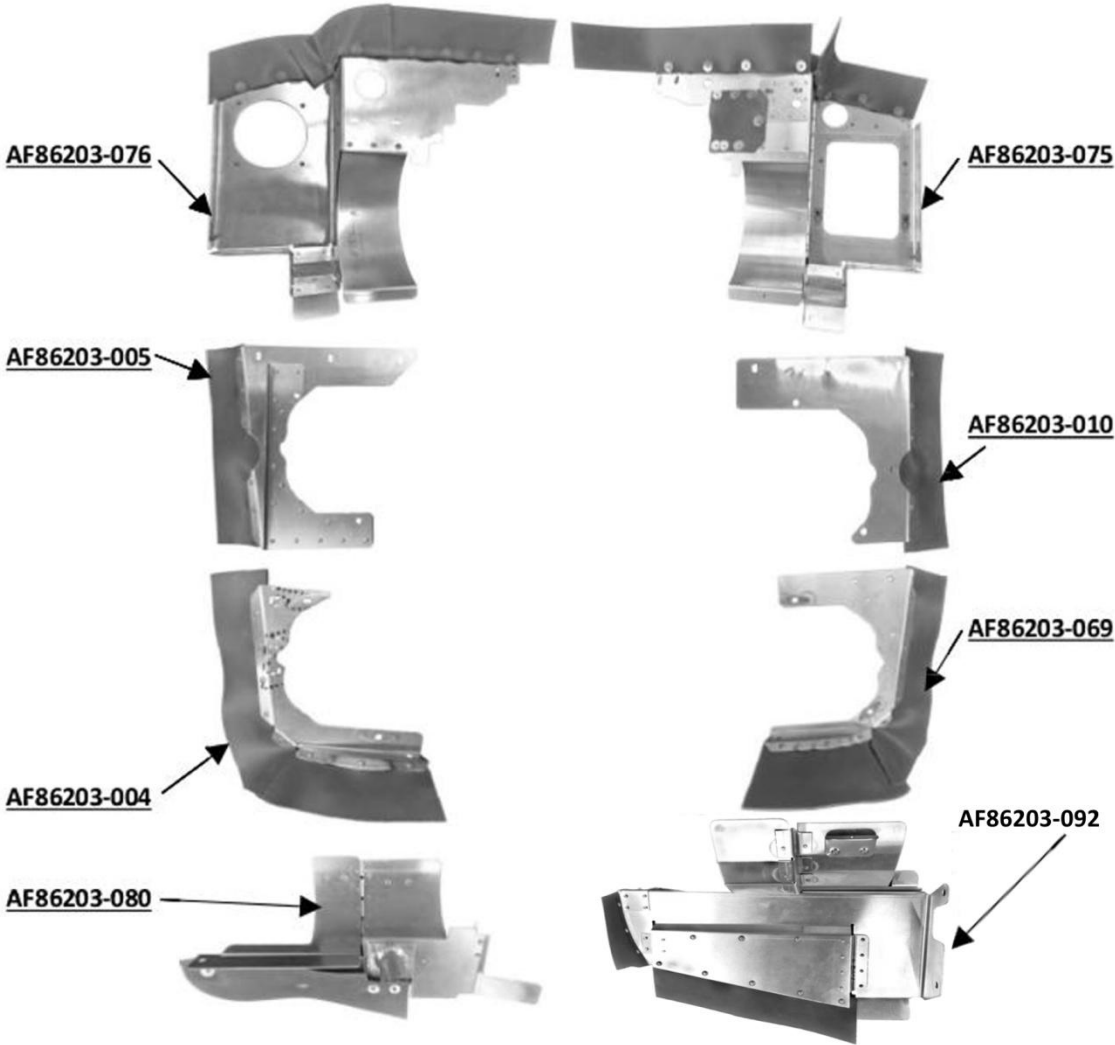


Photo 1: Airforms’ engine baffles for PA-44-180 Seminole aircraft
